- 3** A working party including residents, councillors and young people is set up to manage and monitor the facility.
- 4** An acoustic survey is carried out when the equipment is in use to monitor noise.
- 5** The provision of a visual/acoustic barrier between the tennis courts and the skatepark is researched for the benefit of residents and users of both facilities.
