4.6 Update on proposed yellow lines for Parkway. Timescale to be checked with WCC. Action Clerk

4.7 Update on proposed grit bins for Leafy Lane, these have been promised during July.

4.8 Update road repairs and works pending - Cllr Achwal is keeping a list of current repairs needed.
