 - 4.4 Road repairs and works pending update. A crack on Yew Tree Drive needs repair. **Action Cllr Achwal.**
- 6 **Questions and comments from councillors**
 1. Parking on pavements in residential areas is a problem. **Action Newsletter Team** to include an article in the newsletter reminding residents of the dangers for pedestrians.
 2. Yellow lines promised for Parkway junctions have been held up while legal documents are prepared. **Action District Cllr Hatch** continues to pressurise WCC for work to be completed.
 3. It was questioned whether residential roads should be 20mph. **Action Clerk** will research procedure to reduce speed limits.
 4. Motorbikes are occasionally using the greenways. **Action Newsletter team** to include a note in the newsletter to say this is illegal.
