5.1.1 Parish Plan Action Items – Bus service for after school activities. WPC has agreed to underwrite the cost of part of the bus service cost to ensure it continues during 2006/7.

5.1.2 The results of the bus service were forwarded to HCC and to JMP Consultants who are carrying out the Whiteley Area Travel Plan.

5.2.7 Requests made for:

1. Traffic counts on Whiteley Way. **Received for Whiteley Way and Leafy Lane.**
2. That Whiteley be considered for the HCC speed check van pilot project. **Police have carried out a number of speed checks.**
3. A date for the adoption of Thyme Avenue and Saffron Way. This is in hand. **See more detailed information attached to agenda.**
4. Advice from HCC on whether Marjoram Way link should proceed – see agenda item 5.1 below.
5. That traffic police responsible for Whiteley attend a PC meeting. **Police have carried out a number of speed checks.**
6. A plan of the yellow lines proposed for Mollison Rise and Parkway. **Received.**
7. Hardstandings for bus stops in Whiteley Way. **Request made to HCC, order placed some time ago and will be chased up.**
8. An air pollution study in Whiteley in view of increased traffic on M27. **WCC has no knowledge of this and asked for more information. Reply passed back to Mrs B Hatch.**

5.1 To discuss proposal to complete the Marjoram Way link, to consider a request that it is emergency vehicle access only. ***It was agreed to recommend to Full Council that a request be made for emergency access only. If this is not acceptable a request for pavements both sides of the road to be made.***

5.2 To discuss a request for give way signs and road markings in Bleriot Crescent at the junction with Leafy Lane and Bader Way. ***It was agreed to recommend to Full Council that road markings in the Leafy Lane area are NOT pursued.***

5.3 Repairs and maintenance requests – update on outstanding items. ***An updated list was circulated, please forward any maintenance issues to Chairman or Clerk.***
