## Highways and Transport Committee

Minutes of a meeting of the above Committee held at the Meadowside Leisure Centre, Whiteley on Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> December 2007 at 8.25pm.

1. **To receive apologies for absence:** Cllr Mike Evans
2. **To receive declarations of interest regarding agenda items:** none.
3. **To adjourn meeting to allow participation by members of the public:**  
Cllr Vic Hatch noted a recent press article stating that PUSH was to receive £21 million infrastructure funding.
4. **Meeting resumed to consider the following agenda items:**

4.1 To receive update on proposal to develop plan of action to lobby for improved and more balanced access for Whiteley / report from Highways Working Party. **A report from the Highways Working Party was received at the December Full Council meeting. It was agreed that the committee should draft questions it wishes to raise through the Parish Plan process. Action: Chairman and members.**

4.2 To receive update on request to WCC for 'give way' lines at the Leafy Lane/ Bleriot Crescent junction to be reinstated. **WCC has advised that lines should be reinstated during January 2008.**

4.3 To receive update on affects on Whiteley of Segensworth roundabout works. **Work continues to disrupt traffic flows.**

4.4 To discuss development of North Whiteley and the extension of Whiteley Way. **No further update available.**

4.5 To discuss complaints regarding Lucketts coaches using Leafy Lane and potentially dangerous parking. **The PSCO's have been asked to investigate the problems.**

4.6 To discuss requests for improved bus service for Whiteley including Solent Shuttle. **The Chairman has contacted the operator to ask whether Whiteley can be included in the Solent Shuttle route.**

4.7 To receive update on the following requests to HCC:

4.7.1 Reduction in speed limit for Parkway: **residents have been asked to contact the PC with requests for speed limit reductions in the latest edition of the Whiteley Voice.**

4.7.2 Pedestrian crossing for Yew Tree Drive – results of recent traffic and pedestrian counts. **The results show that a controlled crossing can not be justified at present. There are proposals for improved traffic calming measures for the area that will be considered for funding during 2008/9 as part of the Safer Routes to School Programme.**

4.7.3 Road markings on R1 roundabout: **HCC has advised that it is monitoring the situation.**

4.7.4 Improvements or relocation of Solent 2 / Rookery Ave crossing point: **HCC is looking at the crossing.**

4.8 To receive update on maintenance requests: **no further update, Chairman and Vice-Chairman to meet with HCC Highways Engineer in January.**

4.9 To receive requests for funding for new projects for inclusion in the 2008/9 precept including flashing speed warning signs. **It was agreed to request a budget of £4000 be considered for inclusion in the 2009/9 precept, further research to be carried out. Action Chairman and Clerk.**

**5. Recent correspondence:** HCC notice of start date for Rookery – Swanwick pedestrian/cycle way improvements.

HCC feedback from Yew Tree vehicle and pedestrian count – circulated to all councillors.
