Minutes of a meeting of the above Committee held at the Meadowside Leisure Centre, Whiteley on Wednesday 20th June 2007 at 7.45pm.

4. **To adjourn meeting to allow participation by members of the public:** Cllr Vic Hatch reported that the new crossing on Whiteley Way is being well used.
5. **Meeting resumed to consider the following agenda items:**

5.1 To receive update on proposal to develop plan of action to lobby for opening of Yew Tree Drive to through traffic: **a meeting is to be held with Whiteley Business Forum in July to progress plans.**

5.2 To receive update on proposal to request measures to minimise effect of Segensworth roundabout works on Whiteley residents: **Exhibitions are to be held to present the plans, Councillors to report to next meeting.**
Exhibition dates: Friday 6 July 9am to 4.30pm Whiteley Community Centre, Saturday 7 July 2.30pm to 5.30pm Meadowside Leisure Centre, Friday 13 July 2pm to 8pm and Saturday 14 July 10am to 2.30pm Sarisbury & District Community Centre.

5.3 To receive update on request for road markings for the R1 roundabout: **the Committee unanimously agreed that the Rookery Avenue carriageway widening has made the use of the R1 roundabout more dangerous than before work started. HCC has stated the traffic flows outside of peak hours are not sufficient to warrant arrows or lane markings. It was agreed to publicise this in the Whiteley Voice and to ask residents' opinions.**

5.4 To discuss 'Whiteley Way' fund expenditure: **it was agreed to ask HCC whether the PC can be more involved in future consultations on how the fund is spent. It was agreed to place an article in the Whiteley Voice outlining how the fund works and expenditure to date.**

5.5 To discuss development of North Whiteley and the extension of Whiteley Way: **ongoing, outcome of meeting arranged with developers awaited.**

5.6 To receive an update on progress from the Leafy Lane action group: **a meeting between residents and HCC due to take place on 21st June, update to be provided for next meeting.**
