4.3 To receive update on proposal to develop plan of action to lobby for opening of Yew Tree Drive to through traffic/ report from Highways Working Party: **next Highways Working Party 5th December. HCC has advised that the results for the planned SATURN study will not be available in early 2008 due to additional preparation work required for the project.**

4.4 To receive update on request to WCC for 'give way' lines at the Leafy Lane/ Bleriot Crescent junction to be reinstated. **An order has been placed for the lines.**

4.5 To receive update on affects on Whiteley of Segensworth roundabout works. **No further update available.**

4.6 To discuss development of North Whiteley and the extension of Whiteley Way. **No further update available.**

4.7 To receive update following communication with HCC Chris Lait regarding speeding on Parkway, request for refuge improvements, traffic and pedestrian counts on Yew Tree Drive, road markings on R1 roundabout, request for improvements to Solent 2/Rookery Ave crossing. **A request for residents views on current speed limits and whether there should be reductions in Parkway and/or elsewhere to be placed in the December Whiteley Voice.**

HCC has advised that no further improvements can be made to the refuge.

Results of the Yew Tree count are being checked.

HCC has advised that traffic on R1 roundabout will be monitored following the request for arrow markings at the Rookery junction.

HCC has advised that the Solent 2 / Rookery crossing will be investigated.

4.9 To receive requests for funding for new projects for inclusion in the 2008/9 precept. **No projects suggested.**
