Proposal to develop plan of action to lobby for opening of Yew Tree Drive to through traffic. D Bartram outlined reasons for opening Yew Tree Drive, after some discussion it was decided that the Parish Council should write to Fareham Borough Council Chief Executive requesting the road be opened to all traffic as soon as possible.

Proposal to request measures to minimise effect of Segensworth Roundabout works on Whiteley residents: Work is expected to start in May 2007 with completion during October 2007. Hampshire County Council has said it is to make improvements that will be of benefit to Whiteley residents.

HCC Cllr Allgood as been requested to provide details of how the impact on Whiteley residents will be minimised whilst work is carried out.

To receive an update on progress from the Leafy Lane action group: This was given by Steve Reay and Steve Peters, the group has suggested measures to Hampshire County Council that might help alleviate some of the problems caused by early morning and late afternoon traffic, primarily from the Business Park including: a 'no right turn' at the bottom of Leafy Lane, 'no left turn' from Parkway onto Leafy Lane and also opening up Yew Tree Drive. A written report was copied to the Chairman.
