Minutes of a meeting of the above Committee held at the Meadowside Leisure Centre, Whiteley on Wednesday 26th September 2007 commencing at 8.55pm.

4.2 To discuss request from residents for 'give way' lines at the Leafy Lane/ Bleriot Crescent junction to be reinstated and make recommendation to WCC. **It was agreed to recommend to Full Council that it makes a request to WCC to reinstate the markings. (Four in favour one against)**

4.3 To receive update on affects on Whiteley of Segensworth roundabout works. **See item 3 above.**

4.4 To discuss development of North Whiteley and the extension of Whiteley Way. **No further information.**

4.5 To discuss reply from HCC Chris Lait (emailed to all councillors) regarding speeding on Parkway, request for refuge improvements, traffic and pedestrian counts on Yew Tree Drive and road markings on R1 roundabout. **The survey point for the Yew Tree pedestrian count was confirmed as requested by HCC.**
