## Highways and Transport Committee

Minutes of a meeting of the above Committee held at Meadowside Leisure Centre, Whiteley on Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> May 2009 at 8.55pm.

Concerns raised that the traffic calming humps in Leafy Lane do not comply with regulations for cyclists. A request for 20mph zones in other areas of Whiteley was made. It was noted that the Mollison subway lights are on 24 hours a day. It was agreed to pursue these issues.

6.3 To research the Emergency Action Plan Procedure for Yew Tree Drive rising bollards in the event of an incident at Junction 9 **It was agreed to ask Cllr Allgood for an update on proposals. Action Clerk.**

6.4 To receive update on the yellow line review regarding the parking issues in Parkway and elsewhere. **Further request for update to be made. Action Clerk / Chairman.**

6.5 To receive update on proposed improvements to Whiteley bus services: **no further news. Timetables for bus to Locks Heath are needed in bus shelters. Action Chairman.**

6.6 To receive update on further requests to HCC regarding:

Road markings on R1

Improvement or relocation of Solent Way / Rookery Avenue crossing point

6.7 To receive an update on maintenance requests: **the Chairman is pursuing requests.**
